Special session on *Multi-Unit Probabilistic Safety Assessment*

Description

The session will provide recent results from the development of the IAEA MUPSA methodology Safety Report (SR) and Pilot Activities used as input.

Motivation

MUPSA is a significant area of interest following the Fukushima-Daiichi disaster, to support PSAs that estimate the likelihood of a multi-unit core damage event for sites with two or more units. The IAEA SR documents a detailed approach for MUPSA, as supported by efforts from multiple organizations around the world.

Objective

Present the latest MUPSA methodology, and results from multiple MUPSA studies performed in conjunction with the IAEA SR development.
